

GUIDELINES FOR ALTAIR EVENTS UNDER PHASE 2

Altair Members have been asking the Board to establish some guidelines for Altair events and activities during this Phase 2 reopening of the Covid-19 crisis. To say the least, this is difficult to do as so much is based on circumstances and activities – and can change anytime.

The Board emphasizes that Altair **must** follow the Governor's restrictions at all times. Here is a link to Oregon's Phase 2 Reopening Guidance – Gatherings, which will give you the most current information:

The 3 pages provide guidance for many Altair events and gatherings.

- A maximum of 50 people can gather indoors and maintain 6 ft social distance
- A maximum of 100 people outdoors to maintain the social distance AND contain no more than 10 people groupings

Due to Governor Brown requiring face coverings as of July 1st, the Board is offering the following guidelines for Altair events:

- **INDOOR MEETINGS & EVENTS:** Face coverings must be worn even with social distancing unless eating or drinking.
- **OUTDOOR MEETINGS & EVENTS:** Face coverings are highly encouraged when interacting with others even with social distancing unless eating or drinking.

The Board also reminds Members that Altair guidelines state that **TGIFs in private homes are for MEMBERS ONLY.** This is very important under the current circumstances. Also, the Sign-In/Waiver Forms must be signed by all participants and turned into the Treasurer upon completion of the event. Sign-In/Waiver Forms can be found on the Altair web site under the Forms & Docs tab, item (3b.)

Members will be asked to show their Membership Card at **MEMBERS ONLY** events and many other events!!
